

Charter of the Band of the Red Crescent

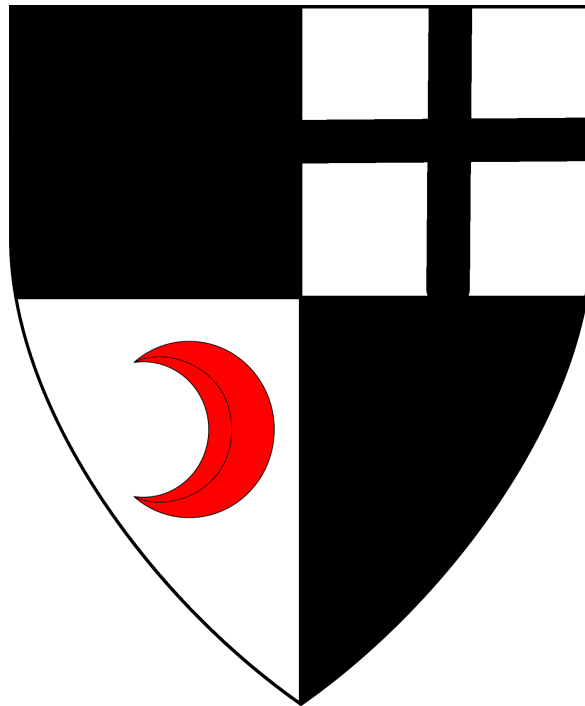
The Red Crescent is a band of ne'er-do-wells, mercenaries and fallen nobility, seeking to gain or to regain their wealth and status; seeking adventure, fellowship and glorious combat along the way.

Location

Historical: The High Medieval Period of Western Europe consisting of England, France, Germany, Italy, Poland and other neighboring countries

Modern: Located at 16255 Water Oak Trail, Fosters, AL 35463

Heraldry: Field quartered, Sable and Argent; Cross on Argent Dexter, Sable; Crescent on Argent Sinister, Gules.



Leadership: A simple system of leadership is employed. The Captain of the Red Crescent stands as leader until they willingly step down, until they are challenged by the members for confidence, or until they are challenged specifically for leadership of the Band.

Challenge by Confidence - Members in Good Standing, (Good Standing being defined as active members for 1 year in the Band), may have a Vote of Confidence to remove the current Captain, it must be a 2/3 majority.

Challenge for Leadership - Any Member in Excellent Standing (Excellent Standing being defined as active membership for at least 2 years in the Band), may Challenge for Leadership

by Combat. Type of Combat and conditions will be set by the Captain, but must be approved by a 51% Majority of Members in Good Standing.

The Captain is responsible for the planning of events, the coordination of the Band and maintaining relations with other groups. The Captain shall under no circumstances order any member of the Band to perform a task they are not willing to do his/herself. The Captain is expected to make sure the Band is armed and fed at all times during events.

Next to the Captain there is his/her Second, they will be responsible for assisting the Captain in any way possible and in the event of the Captain's death, shall temporarily take their place until a new Captain is formally announced. The Second shall be responsible for defending the Captain's honor and may take the place of the Captain in a duel if the Captain is not physically able to fight, unable to attend, or simply wishes not to fight. The Second is chosen by the Captain alone. When the Captain is replaced the new Captain may choose to replace their Second if they so please. The Second's service is expected until they are replaced, or fall in battle, however if they choose to step down from their position they may do so with no consequences, however this will be viewed as highly disrespectful of the Second by the rest of the Band.
